CDF Online is an Internet transactional facility available for individual clients and church organisations.

Services Available

- Account Balance
- Transaction Details
- Transfer funds to and from nominated bank, building society or credit union accounts
- Transfer funds between your CDF accounts
- Last financial year's interest details

Please note that proceeds of transfers from CDF made before 2.00pm on any business day will be available in your nominated bank account as cleared funds on the following day. Late transfers are subject to a 24 hour delay.

How do I gain access to CDF Online?

To register for CDF Online, **log-on to CDF website www.melbcdf.org.au** and click either the Individual or Church Client buttons, go to Forms and download the Application under "Online". Send the completed documents to CDF, after which you will receive the log-on instructions by email.

How do I get started?

Simply follow the instructions sent to you by email. You will first need to change the password initially provided to you to a personally chosen password.
